

## Bureau Technical Inspection impartiality policy.

Impartiality is a necessary and indispensable condition of ensuring the credibility of the certification process and the certification decision.

Bureau Technical Inspection OÜ (further BTI) as the certification body of welders and welding procedures is independent of the organizations, products, processes and services which certifies, preventing thus any possibility of administrative, commercial, financial and (or) other pressure to affect the results of the certification. This ensures objectivity and impartiality in the implementation of the certification activities.

BTI management states that fully understands the importance of impartiality in the execution of the certification and is aware of all significant threats and take the necessary actions to eliminate them.

BTI identifies, analyzes and documents the possible risks and conflicts of interest arising in the course of certification, including the risks arising from its relationships, including relationships with its customers.

BTI does not carry out certification, if the relationship with the customer become an imminent threat to ensure impartiality.

BTI does not represent or allow the use for promotional purposes any statements that the certification will be more simple, easy, fast, or less expensive.

BTI does not attract to participate in the work of the certification any persons providing consulting services to the customer organization.

BTI requires all staff to immediately report any potential conflicts of interest and emerging threats to impartiality and ensures that they will take all necessary actions to eliminate them.
